



FBE FUNDRAISER FAQs

What is the FBE Fundraiser?

The FBE Fundraiser is a fantastic event where community members, school administration and faculty, and FBE corporate sponsors come together to dine, dance, and donate. Attendees enter a celebration location transformed into a visual spectacle where there could be a secret agent around every corner or your dealer could be in disguise. Bring your partner, your friends, and your coworkers. Enter Casino Royale and prepare for a wild night

When do ticket sales close? Can I buy a ticket at the event?

Tickets are available at www.fbe-belmont.org/fundraiser until they sell out, which happens quite quickly. Tickets are \$125/each until February 29th, at which time they increase to \$150/each. Tickets are not available at the door, but if you want to check on last-minute ticket availability, please contact info@fbe-belmont.org.

What are the live auction items?

Live auction items are generally packages of unique experiences. A detailed list of these items will be posted on the FBE website a few weeks before the event and will be emailed to all attendees before the event. This year, packages include domestic and foreign travel excursions, concert experiences, dinner party packages, and much more.

Can groups of people bid on live auction items?

Absolutely! Many live auction items are for larger groups and bidding can get quite competitive. Come prepared, pool your funds, and leave the event with an auction package that you and your friends can enjoy together.

How do I pay for items at the fundraiser?

When purchasing tickets for the FBE Fundraiser, you have the option of keeping your credit card on file for use at the fundraiser or you can register a credit card when you arrive at the event. The credit card on file can be used for the silent auction, live auction, first choice raffle, and Fund A Need portions of the evening. The bar accepts cash or credit cards.

If you win a live auction item, you will be given these items (or additional information about the item) when you leave, so don't forget to stop by the check-out table before you head home.

What food is served at the event?

You won't go hungry! Passed hors d'oeuvres will be served during the cocktail hour and a buffet dinner will be served prior to the live auction. There will be many dining options, sure to satisfy even those with the most discerning tastes.

What is the dress code for the event?

Wear whatever moves you! While the invitation states "Think Bond, James Bond" if your inner secret agent wants to shine, have at it. Feeling like a villain, go for it. Many attendees go all out and embrace the event theme, but it's totally up to you.

I can't find a babysitter, but still want to attend. Do people come without a partner?

Yes! Many attendees come with friends, neighbors, or co-workers to the party.

I don't have a child in the school system. Is this event for me?

Yes, yes, and yes.

The First Choice Auction is a favorite part of the night. To participate, you purchase a special Bond-inspired numbered item. If your number matches the winning number, you get FIRST CHOICE pick of ANY LIVE AUCTION item. Only 100 numbered items are sold, so your odds of winning are great.
