



## How to Play Blackjack & Roulette

\*\*\*Please note – these are general guidelines. Rules for games at the event casino may differ slightly from the guidelines listed below.

### Blackjack

1. Blackjack starts with players making bets.
2. Dealer deals two cards to the players and two to himself (1 card face up, the other face down).
3. Blackjack card values: All cards count as their face value in blackjack. Picture cards count as 10 and the ace can count as either 1 or 11. Card suits have no meaning in blackjack.
4. The total of any hand is the sum of the card values in the hand.
5. Players must decide whether to stand (to play one's hand as dealt), hit (to ask for another card), surrender (give up the hand), double down (double your bet), or split (to split cards into two hands).
6. The dealer acts last and must hit on 16 or less and stand on 17 through 21.
7. Players win when their hand totals higher than the dealer's hand, or they have 21 or less when the dealer busts (i.e., exceeds 21).

### Roulette

1. Roulette starts with players making bets.
2. The croupier (or dealer) throws a ball into the spinning roulette wheel. Players can still make bets within the process.
3. While the ball is rolling at the roulette wheel, the croupier/dealer announces: "No more bets."
4. At that point players are not allowed to make bets
5. The ball lands on a number in the roulette wheel. If there are winners who bet the number, section, or color, they will be rewarded according to their betting odds.
